

Romeo & Juliet Homework Choice

Choose one task to complete each week for your homework! You can do the same AMBER or GREEN task more than once to show progress.

Using evidence, write at least 3 paragraphs explaining how friendship is portrayed in the play. You could discuss Romeo's friendship with any of the other characters.

Create a fact sheet on attitudes towards females and children in Elizabethan times.

Write at least 3 paragraphs explaining how women are portrayed in the play. Give evidence using Act 1 Scene 1 and compare to another part of the play.

In Act 3, Juliet calls Romeo a "Beautiful tyrant, fiend angelical". Explain what this suggests about Juliet's feelings towards Romeo at this point in the play.

Write at least 3 paragraphs explaining how parent/child relationships are portrayed in the play. Use evidence from throughout the play.

How does Romeo speak about Juliet in Act 2 Scene 2? Use evidence and AO2 techniques to explain. Write a minimum of 3 paragraphs.

Write at least 3 paragraphs explaining how power is portrayed in the play. Give evidence from anywhere in the play.

Summarise the plot of the play into a storyboard. You should refer to all key parts of the play and ensure that you present it in chronological order.

Write at least 3 paragraphs explaining how love and marriage are portrayed in the play. Give evidence from when Romeo & Juliet first meet and from when they get married.

These homeworks will support your understanding of the play. RED = easy, AMBER = medium, GREEN = challenge.
