

## Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde Homework Tasks: Year 11

The purpose of these homeworks is to extend and develop your understanding of the novel and practise the exam skills.

You must choose and complete 7 of the following tasks. You must complete at least **one** challenge (green) task. You may only choose two easier (red) ones and as many mid-range (yellow) ones as you wish.

<p><b><u>Sentence Starters: Task 1:</u></b> Learn the sentence starters so that you can use them in your class work. (See sentence starters sheet).</p>	<p><b><u>Task 2:</u></b> <b>Research Task: Themes you need to research and make notes on:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The duality of man</li><li>• Science and the unexplained</li><li>• The Victorian Gentleman &amp; his reputation</li><li>• Violence</li><li>• Secrets and mystery</li><li>• Fear and horror</li><li>• The Urban Gothic</li></ul>	<p><b><u>Task 3: For each character:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Consider why they are important in the novel. Why do you think Stevenson included this character?</li><li>2. Consider how the character changes in the novel. How does this character develop as the novel progresses?</li><li>3. Identify the key moments for this character. Which section of the novel do they play an important part in?</li></ol>
